1. <u>APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE</u>

An Apology for Absence was received from Miss M Smith (prior commitment) and Borough Councillor, Mr G Bradford.

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4. BOROUGH COUNCILLORS REPORT

Mrs Hicks gave everyone present a copy of the ABC report 'People serving people.

The Council is very keen to get the Elwick Road development under way.

Officers from the Planning Department paid an unscheduled visit to the Duck Lane site and the applicant gave them additional information. ABC is currently seeking legal advice on the application.

The Government has brought out a Gypsy Policy for guidance to local authorities.

5. <u>COUNTY COUNCILLORS REPORT</u>

Councillor Angell informed those present that KCC has to save £240 million over the next 3 years and members are currently looking to see whether any services they are not legally obliged to provide can be discontinued.

Mr Angell is concerned at the amount of NHS time taken up in A & E Departments by those, mainly aged between 18 and 24, who are injured or ill due to alcohol or drug abuse. He wants KCC to work with the police and KHS and be seen to be leading the way in improving the current situation.

We are still waiting for a reply from ABC regarding the damage to the bus shelter.

Mr Hollands reported that a resident of Molloy Road had asked for a number of trees in the Recreation Field that overhang her garden to be cut back. Councillors unanimously agreed that Mr Hollands should organise this.

Mr Hollands reported that he did not agree with the proposed boundary change. Mrs Hicks will discuss this with ABC.
