# Discussion and Decision on action to be taken on any other matters related to Planning issues within the Parish

# Land Rear of Hornash Lane, Hornash House - OBJECT

- We believe that this is the oldest house in the village and is therefore of much more historic significance than the application implies. The Parish Council is extremely upset that the conservation of this building has not been a priority to ABC
- Overdevelopment of the site
- Beyond the village confines: 1<sup>st</sup> house is inside, 2<sup>nd</sup> house is half and half, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> houses are outside
- The application form answers "no" to any "new or altered vehicular access proposed to or from the public highway". I would see this as incorrect as the proposed plan is going from 2 car access to 20. The fire brigade is concerned that the access is insufficient that will cause a larger access. This will impact the listed building
- Considering it's a grade 2 listed building I would be concerned about the visual impact of the new buildings it seems very cluttered and not in keeping with the surrounding buildings space
- The plans seem poorly thought through, not giving any thought to the types of materials used bearing in mind the proximity to a listed building; the heights and bulks of the proposed houses are inappropriate for the setting
- There is a road opening at the end which would give a further opening to the field behind. If this is approved (my thinking is strongly object or approve an additional one house only) perhaps the land trust could get involved and secure a strip of land to prevent any further development into the fields behind.

These details will be formalised for subsequent submission.
