## APPENDIX A – CHAIRMAN'S REPORT Chairman's Report to Shadoxhurst Parish Council April 2023

The Parish Council has again been quite busy over the last month, the activities will be discussed in the individual group reports. Some progress in some places.

1. Planning for the New Pavilion for the Recreation Field has been approved but with two conditions that make it unusable for our requirements. These are that the building is exclusively a Pavilion and not a community facility as we have envisaged, and the hours of operation are too restrictive. David & I have gone back to the Planning Offer to see how this can be resolved.

- 2. Although the Stodmarsh issue doesn't seem to be resolved, ABC are moving with some of the applications where we have surface and foul water concerns. We, together with the Shadoxhurst Utilities Team are watching this carefully.
- 3. There has been some progress with Hornash House. ABC now seem to be working well with the owner who has got a strong conservation team around him.
- 4. Finally, the 7 current members of the Parish Council were the only ones to be nominated for the election of May 4<sup>th</sup>, so we have all been elected unopposed. I look forward to working with the new council from next month.
